Clare Haven Services After-school activities assistant

Clare Haven Services provide support, information and refuge accommodation to women and their children experiencing Domestic Violence/Abuse.

World Record Attempt Knitted Blanket

A team of volunteers are working hard to try and beat the World Record for the worlds largest blanket. Volunteers are needed to knit 6" squares in any type of wool to reach the target of 60,000 squares.

After the World Record is broken, the blanket will be divided into smaller blankets and donated to the Red Cross. The volunteer committee have received donations of wool and is able to provide any prospective knitters with as much wool as they need.

The project was officially launched on the 7th January and this is a great opportunity to get involved either as an individual contributor or as part

of the sticher uppers who meet on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday mornings.
