Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann 2017 Volunteer Programme

Would you like to join our team and be part of Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann Ennis 2017? The Clare Volunteer Centre is looking for volunteers for the 13th – 21st August 2017

Street Stewards: Do you have a good knowledge of Ennis and its streets? Can you give clear direction in a courteous but firm manner? Are you comfortable directing large groups of people? A team of volunteers are working hard to try and beat the World Record for the worlds largest blanket. Volunteers are needed to knit 6" squares in any type of wool to reach the target of 60,000 squares.

After the World Record is broken, the blanket will be divided into smaller blankets and donated to the Red Cross.

The project was officially launched on the 7th January and this is a great opportunity to get involved either as an individual contributor or as part of the sticher uppers who meet on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday mornings. Volunteer Youth Leader Clare Youth Service

The Clare Youth Service is currently looking for volunteer leaders to get involved a "Youth Café Project" based in Ennis. This is a project aimed at young people aged 13 - 18yrs. The project is run by a committee of 7 young leaders and they have currently up to 18 young people attending each Saturday from 1pm - 3pm.

Volunteer tasks will include assisting and organising various activities; engaging with the youth café members to manage and maintain the space, attending weekly meetings. The volunteer will be required to undergo Child Protection Training as well as an induction. This is an ideal opportunity for someone that is looking to gain experience with working with youth as part of a social care course or just that they like working with young people.
